The French government made him a Commander of the Order of Arts and Letters. He is a Grand Officer of the French Legion d'Honneur, and a Grand Officer of the Republic of Italy. He is a Commander of the Order of Santiago in Portugal, the oldest military Order on the Continent, and a Commander of the Order of Leopold II and of the Order of Leopold I of Belgium; he is also a Commander of the Republic of Chile, and of the Order of Orange-Nassau of Holland. He holds the Grand Cross of Alfonso El Sabio. He is an Officer of the Order of Polonia Restituta. He has received the Medal Benemerenti of Roumania, and is a Correspondent Member of the Academy of Music of Brazil; he is an Honorary Member of the famous Academia di Santa Cecilia in Rome, and an Associate Member of the Academie des Beaux Arts of the French Institute. The Royal Philharmonic Society of London has conferred upon him its gold Beethoven Medal.

He holds Honorary Doctorates in Music from the Universities of Brown, Columbia, Northwestern, Rutgers, Southwestern, Tufts, UCLA, and Yale (where he was honored at the same time as President Kennedy).

In 1974 he received an Honorary Doctorate of Philosophy from the Hebrew University of Jerusalem.
